

Year 1 RM/LJ Week Beginning: 08/06/2020

We hope you are all happy and healthy. There are suggestions below to direct you towards skills you can develop at home with your child.

Maths and Numeracy

- Practice number bonds, counting in 2's, 5's, 10's and adding/subtracting.

This Week's Focused Learning

- To recognise 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p and 20p. To understand the value of 2p, 5p, 10p and 20p coins.
- 1. Show children these coins. Talk about the size and colour and of each of the coins. Put a pile of coins in the middle of the table. Can you sort them into pile of 1 pences, 2 pences etc. Ask a grown up to pick up a coin and ask you 'What is the value of this coin? How do you know?' Repeat with other coins. Play Pirate Coin game. *This is on Seesaw.* Play Topmarks coin recognition game.
- 2. Talk about the value of the coins and that coins can be added together to make different values. Show how to make the different values. How many 1pence pennies will you need to make 2p? 5p? 10p, 20p. Repeat with other coins
- 3. Do some coin rubbings.

Language, Literacy and Communication

- Practise your spelling of all Tricky Words. Can you write a variety of different sentences using these tricky words?
- Listen to your child read a reading book at home.
- Explore the books on [WorldeBook](#) and [Oxford Owl](#)
- Explore [Phonics play](#)

This Week's Focused Learning

Language, Literacy and Communication:

We are going to be learning about information texts. Look at the power point presentation and see what you can learn from it. *This is on Seesaw.* Look at the worksheet. *This is on Seesaw.* Can you label the features? Definition of these term are on *Seesaw.* (contents page, heading, index, photograph, caption and label)

Welsh: Revise colours. Hold up objects of different colours and ask the question 'Pa lliw?'. Ask question 'Pa lliw wyt ti'n hoffi?' (which colour do you like?) Dw i'n hoffi... (I like...) Learn vocabulary for school activities. Look at the power point as a grown up to help you with the pronunciation. *This is on Seesaw.* Choose 5 activities that are your favourite. Draw a picture of yourself doing the activity and write a sentence 'Dw i'n hoffi.....' (I like.....). Do this in your exercise book.



Science and Technology

- Make a feely collage using a variety of different materials. Discuss their properties and write three sentences about the materials. Remember your adjectives.



Expressive Arts

- Musycling - make some instruments using recycled materials. *There are ideas on Seesaw.* Make at least one. Then investigate which one makes the best sound. How can you improve it?
